

Award of Merit

The PCAV Criteria

The Award of Merit is the highest service award for pony club associate members aged at least 19 years, at the time of nomination for the award.

Service for this award means carrying out tasks that benefit the club, its members and perhaps the wider community.

Service does not include riding ability or competing in teams.

The nominee may receive the award once only.

To be considered worthy of nomination for this award, the nominee must have:

- Been a member of a pony club for at least three years and attended rallies as often as possible during that time
- Always been helpful, considerate and courteous to all involved with the pony club
- Always presented and conducted themselves in an exemplary manner
- Completed outstanding service (as defined above at the least), to the club for a minimum of two years.

Each year the state council requests clubs to submit nominations to their zone.

The zones set their own closing date. However, zone nominations must reach the state council by 15 June. All nominees must be financial.
