

National Mounted Games

Pony Club Australia conducts an annual Australian mounted games championship for senior teams, age 17 to 25 yrs, known as the National Mounted Games (NMG) and junior teams, under 17, known as the Prince Phillip Games (PPG). For the Victorian team, the PCAV undertakes a selection process each year with riders around the State, who try-out for squad selection. The senior and junior squads then proceed through a strenuous training regime over some months, until final team selections. The teams represent Victoria in their respective Australian championship competitions, which are held in one of the six Australian states or Northern Territory.

Note: the NMG was prior to 2005, known as the 'Masters Prince Phillip Games' .
